Atelier: A CA Data Session

Résumé: This session will follow the format of a Conversation Analysis (CA) data session. Such sessions are chiefly conducted to hone skills for looking and listening. Materials presented in a data session are usually unpublished and, as a consequence, the work of the session is exploratory. The data to be presented in this session come from the SIU Surgical Education Video Corpus, a collection of video recordings detailing teaching in the operating room. Ten minutes will be reserved at the end to discuss issues of informed consent, recording, transcription, archival storage, etc.
